



## DIRECTIONS TO COMBE MANOR

### From Newbury :

Take A4 towards Hungerford. Turn left signed to Kintbury, over humped bridges and level crossing. Take 2<sup>nd</sup> left in Kintbury (Inkpen Road). Continue up hill, through village, past Bistro Roque restaurant on left, over cemetery crossroads and down a dip and up the other side. Go straight on, following signs to Inkpen Common. After 0.5 miles turn left immediately after The Crown and Garter pub, signed Combe and Faccombe. At next T junction turn left to Combe and Faccombe. Continue on same road, up hill for 0.5 miles – road bears to the right signed to Combe. At the top of very steep hill, turn sharp left and continue down steep hill for approximately 1 mile. Road bends to right signed to Linkenholt and Netherton. Combe Manor is 200 yards of right on a hair-pin bend by the church.

### From Andover :

Take A343 towards Newbury. On leaving Hurstbourne Tarrant, fork left opposite Bourne Valley Autos – Texaco garage signed posted Netherton, Faccombe and Linkenholt. Keep on same road for 3 miles, through hamlet of Netherton. Continue on that road for approximately 2 miles to Combe. Combe Manor is on a hair-pin bend by the church.

### From Hungerford :

A 338 (Salisbury Road) Hungerford High Street. Turn up Park Street (opposite Wine Rack), signed to Station and Long Stay Car Park, passing Police Station on left and over cattle grid by the Downgate pub. Take 1<sup>st</sup> right on the Common signed to Inkpen, and over another cattle grid. Go approximately 1.8 miles, following signs to Inkpen – very wiggly road. Do not turn right to Saddlers Road – continue on this road through Inkpen past the Swan pub on left. At T junction by telephone box, turn right to Ham and Combe and then immediately left to Upper Inkpen and Combe Gibbet. Continue for 1.5 miles to the top of the hill. At the top of the hill carry on the same road, down steep hill for approximately 1 mile. Road bends to right signed to Linkenholt and Netherton. Combe Manor is 200 yards on right on a hair-pin bend by the Church.
